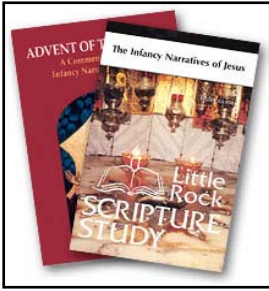

Fridays are 2:00 dismissals for teacher professional development. Children will need to be enrolled in Extended Daycare, fees apply. Please contact Mrs. Ascenzi at 623-931-7288 to discuss your child's educational needs.

Our curriculum is developmentally appropriate and consists of a variety of preschool methods. We believe one method of teaching is not always supportive of the child. We believe the children should be allowed to learn and develop at their own rate. Academics should begin when the children show an interest or are developmentally ready. This can best be accomplished through the children's natural play, hands on experiences, and interactions with others.

We are pleased to announce the introduction of the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (Atrium) program, fall of 2009. This program assists our children in their "Spiritual Journey" with God through prayer and exploration.

*Starting Monday, January 4, 2010, OLPH will offer a mini-3's program for children who have just turned 3 years of age by January 1, 2010. This program will be offered on enrollment contingency on Mondays and Wednesdays from 8:00-11:00 am at a cost of \$125.00/month with the \$100.00 non-refundable registration fee. The goal of this program will be to guide our young children through a Spiritual, enriching and socialization curriculum who otherwise would not be ready for an all day program. 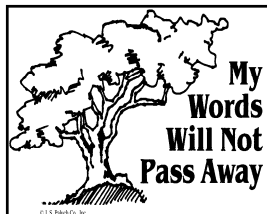
